Instruction of examination

Statistics for Business & Economics January-February 2023

The assessment (see details below) consists of a written exam and an oral defence of the report. The written exam and the oral defence will take place **in presence for all the students**, with the exception of those students who are affected by disability as attested by the University.

For all the students

After registering on ESSE3 (within 5 days before the date of exam as by rules), students will be contacted via ESSE3 on their institutional email address for the Microsoft link **just before the recognition** which will take place as follows:

- 1. For the examination of 16/01/2023, the recognition will take place on Friday 13/01/2023, 10.00 am;
- 2. For the examination of 1/02/2023, the recognition will take place on Monday 30/01/2023, 10.00 am;
- 3. For the examination of 15/02/2023, the recognition will take place on Monday 13/02/2023, 10.00 am.

In case recognition dates overlap with dates of other exams, students are requested to send an email to the Professor with indication of the exam concerned before 10.00 am of the same day. After the exam, students are requested to send another email to arrange for identification. They will be contacted via Microsoft Teams immediately after. **If students do not show up** on the day of the identification, they cannot attend the exam.

Written exam and oral defence in presence

Students will attend the exams in presence at the University of L'Aquila, zone Acquasanta. The date of the oral defence will be communicated to the students the day of the written exam.

Remote (online) exam.

For students who are affected by disability as attested by the University, they are requested to inform the Professor by email for the need to taking the remote written and oral exam on Microsoft Teams before the time of recognition and no later than that, under penalty of exclusion from the exam.

For those who will take the remote written exam, professor will send the appropriate link (TEAMS) via ESSE3 to students on the day the recognition is called. The station to carry out the written exam at a distance is indicated below



In case of interruption, before and during the exam, due to the poor connection, professor will reserve the right to evaluate the exam. During the exam, students are not allowed to record the exam or leave the workstation. Students must remain connected in audio and video until the end of the exam, under penalty of exclusion from the exam.

The same rules are applied to oral exam (defence).

Assessment

The assessment consists of two parts:

- a) A written exam: three numerical questions.
- b) A report of 2000 words, which students must write and defend. The oral deference will take place for all the students on a date which will be made public after the written exam.

The report must be sent 3 days (72 hours) before the date of the written exam. **The students must use their institutional email address** (....@univaq.it) to send their report. Otherwise, they won't be able to attend the exam.

The report must be sent along with MATLAB code and data. The subject of the email must contain title of the course, word "report", name and surname of the

student along with the ID number. <u>If students fail to pass the exam</u>, **it is requested** to write a new report for the next attempt.
